The MEETLES are a Beatles Tribute band that plays regularly in New York City, both underground via the MTA's Music Under New York program and above ground near Central Park's Strawberry Fields. Comprised of musicians who've spent years mastering the music of The Beatles and The 1960s British Invasion, The MEETLES feature Eric on drums, Naomi on bass & vocal, Rob on rhythm guitar, keys & vocal, Barry on lead guitar, Maggie, Yusuke, Steve on rhythm guitar & vocal, Danny on vocal, Tarun on harmonium & trumpet, and Andy on flute & percussion. The band is often joined by guest musicians who play and sing with them at Beatles sing-a-longs. The MEETLES' role in creating these fun-filled musical gatherings is why they're known as "New York's Most Fun Beatles Tribute Band."

### **Where Can I See and Hear THE MEETLES in Person?**

THE MEETLES are a member of the MTA's Music Under New York program, so they can be found each weekend rocking subway stations at 42nd Street, 34th Street, Penn Station, and other underground venues. Additionally, The MEETLES play in Central Park -- just a few steps away from John Lennon's memorial at Strawberry Fields -- on Sunday afternoons when weather permits.
